POST OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

- **1.** For pain and inflammation, take **600 mg (3 tablets of 200mg**) of Ibuprofen (Advil) every **4 hours** for the first **3 days**.
- 2. The doctor will only prescribe antibiotics if they deem it necessary. If prescribed, take 2 tablets of Amoxicillin (antibiotic) after lunch or dinner today. Then take 1 tablet three times a day with food (at breakfast, lunch, and dinner). (Note: you need something in your stomach because too much medication can cause vomiting.)
- 3. A soft diet is recommended for the first 2 weeks after surgery.
- **4.** Apply **Cold Compress** to affected area for the first **24 hours for 15-20 minutes on and then 15-20 minutes off.** (Note: If there is swelling after 24 hours, then use Warm Compress for 15-20 minutes on and then 15-20 minutes off.)
- 5. Sleep with your head elevated the first night following surgery.
- **6.** Make sure you apply the **Peridex rinse twice a day** to the affected area only with an applicator (i.e. Q-tip). (Note: Do Not Rinse as it could stain your teeth.)
- 7. Keep the area clean by **brushing lightly** in the area.
- **8**. **Do not forcefully spit** when brushing/ cleaning the area. Let the water fall out over the sink. Creating force in the mouth may cause stitches to come out.
- **9**. **Do not lift lip** to look at the stitches as this may cause them to rupture.
- 10. Do not smoke as smoking prolongs healing time.
